

Career Transition Services



Career Transition Services are provided to help Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) Veterans make a successful transition from their military to their civilian career. The program offers you financial assistance of up to \$1,000 to acquire career services to identify your skills and strengths learned in your military career so they can be applied to your search for civilian employment. This includes services such as aptitude and skills analysis, job market research, and help in developing a professional résumé.

Who qualifies for financial assistance to acquire career transition services?

You may qualify if you are:

1. a CAF Veteran who completed basic training and was honourably discharged;
2. a CAF Reservist who completed at least 21 months of full-time service during 24 consecutive months, or who has special duty service or emergency service;
3. the survivor of one of the above or of a Reservist who had committed to meet this service when they died; or
4. in receipt of Canadian Forces Income Support.

In most cases, you must apply within two years of your military service or, in the case of survivors, within two years from the date your spouse's or partner's death. Exceptions to this requirement are commonly made when circumstances prevent you from applying within the two-year time limit.
